

## **Eight Simple Rules for Gas Cylinder Safety**

- 1. Always move cylinders with their caps on.
- 2. Always turn cylinders off when not in use (end of the day).
- 3. Always have cylinders secured in its holder.
- Always turn the cylinder valve (a crack) before putting on the regulator. This blows off any dust or impurities.
- Always back out the P/A (output pressure) screw before installing the regulator. Back it
  out to a point of tension free spin. After installing the regulator, re-adjust the P/A screw to
  the normal required pressure.
- 6. Always bleed off the pressure from the regulator before removing it.
- 7. Always turn on a cylinder slowly and stand to the side of the regulator.
- 8. Always ask if you are not sure about how to use a cylinder or regulator.
