## **Eight Simple Rules for Gas Cylinder Safety**

1. Always move cylinders with their caps on.
2. Always turn cylinders off when not in use (end of the day).
3. Always have cylinders secured in its holder.
4. Always turn the cylinder valve (a crack) before putting on the regulator. This blows off any dust or impurities.
5. Always back out the P/A (output pressure) screw before installing the regulator. Back it out to a point of tension free spin. After installing the regulator, re-adjust the P/A screw to the normal required pressure.
6. Always bleed off the pressure from the regulator before removing it.
7. Always turn on a cylinder slowly and stand to the side of the regulator.
8. Always ask if you are not sure about how to use a cylinder or regulator.
